Bred in the purple (or red) by **Ch Belleville Burning Passion** out of **Ch Belleville Intuition** he was born at the end of October 2012.

The Reserve Bitch CC went to the Junior Bitch, **KINSRIDGE TOP TIP**, who has won 2 CCs this year. Bred and owned by Di Jenkins, she is by Ch Kinsridge Top Gun out of Am Ch Kinsridge Hot Tip.

She is only 2 years 3 months old and after being place Group 3 in Scotland, she temporarily retired until returning in September at City of Birmingham where she was the RCC; so far she has won 3 CCs this year, with a total of 6 in all plus 4 RCCs from just 10 shows.

Ruth Gee won both the RCCs with **WATERCROFT IN A PICKLE**

Before this they were classed as Drop-eared Norwich. This Championship show celebrating our 50th year was held at the Royal Court Hotel, Keresley near Coventry on Saturday 27th September. The judge for this special show was **Mrs Dorothy Dorkins** (*Lowmita*) who has also played a great part in arranging the actual event and celebrations.

The Britannia Suite looked terrific with white fencing round the green 'grass' strips protecting the hotel's red carpet, with chairs all round, and photographs on the walls and tables placed round the edge of the room for the Norfolk Stand and other displays – of silver cups, prizes and the special items for the Grand Draw and Auction. The only problem being that the green mats tended to 'walk' on the under carpet and became a bit

rucked up. There were extra classes included at this special show, so that there was a total of 109 Norfolks entered, 42 dogs and 67 bitches. There were 49 entries of dogs with just 2 dogs actually absent, and 81 entries of bitches, with 11 bitches absent; several Norfolks were entered in more than one class.

To great applause, Cathy Thompson-Morgan's dog CC winner was pronounced Best In Show. Black & tan **CH BELLEVILE SEDUCTION** is by **Ch Belleville** Burning Passion out of **Ch Belleville Intuition**. This was 7th CC this year, 8 in all, and he has been BoB 6 times.

Reserve Best In Show, the Bitch CC and Best Opposite sex was **WATERCROFT TOP TIA**, this was her first CC, but she comes from a remarkable litter that has already produced a champion in Watercroft Top Of The Pops. She is by Ch Kinsridge Top Gun out of Watercroft Hot Cake. She has only recently returned to the ringside after producing a litter, which included Watercroft Dream Topping who won the Junior bitch class.

The RCC in dogs went to **STRATHINVER SMART ENOUGH**, owned and shown by Norma Newton. He has won 2 CCs so far, one this year, and this is his 2nd RCC this year. He is by the Swedish dog Guestlings Fairbanks at Kinsridge (imp) out of Strathinver Red Red Rose.

Best of Breed in Norfolks winning his 5th CC was black & tan CH BELLEVILLE SEDUCTION – his pedigree is remarkable, for nearly all names are in red in his first three generations, there are only two dogs who are not champions, as he is by Ch Belleville Burning Passion out of Ch Belleville Intuition. His kennel mate in contrast who also won her 5th bitch CC at this show, CH BELLEVILLE JUST MAGIC, can only display four champions in red in her pedigree in the first three generations. She is by Belleville Shoelace Maker out of Belleville Magic Dice.

Both RCCs were the first major awards for both dogs. Mary Atkinson's black & tan **BLAKENS I LOOK TO YOU**, bred by Jackie Phillips, won the DRCC and then went on to win Best Puppy. He is a repeat mating, two years younger to last year's top winner Ch Blakens Xpress Yourself, both are by Ch Moortop No Choice out of Vision Express at Blakens.

Karen Hurrion's **VILLASSA STAR TURN** won the bitch RCC; she is by Wharfvalley Diamond Star out of Ch Valentines Cherry Crumble; she is similarly bred to Ch Villassa Cherry Ripple, as they share the same dam but the sires were litter brothers, Ripple being by Wharfvalley Diamond Bright at Moortop.

A week after Birmingham **Mrs Cathy Thompson-Morgan** (*Belleville*) judged Norfolks on Friday 16th May, at the Royal Highland Showground, Ingliston, near Edinburgh. The long trek to Scotland proved a very worthwhile journey for Jackie Phillips as Cathy made her bitch **CH BLAKENS SUGAR CANDY KISSES** Best of Breed after winning the bitch CC and later in the afternoon she was Group Three in the Terrier Group judged by **Mr Dave Scawthorne**, who has bred Norfolks in partnership with Judy Averis under the Saredon affix. This was her 5th CC, and she is the litter sister of Blakens The Kandy Man Kan, both being by Brenin Bazaar at Kinsridge out of **Ch Vichea Pick And Mix**.

The Dog CC went to Norma Newton's **STRATHINVER SMART ENOUGH**, his second such award. He is by the Swedish imported dog Guestlings Fairbanks at Kinsridge out of Strathinver Red Red Rose (Rouletta Fameuse Le Smart x Strathinver Be Smart).

Ruth Gee and her Watercroft Kennel also did well, as she won both RCCs and Best Puppy. **WATERCROFT IN A PICKLE** was the dog RCC and **WATERCROFT TOP OF THE POPS** won the Bitch RCC. Their dams are litter sisters, W. Hot Love and W Hot Cake, both by Ch Belleville

Angello out of Watercroft Hot Stuff (SA Ch Macsnest Nik The Kaluha at Collaton x Saving Grace). Pickle though is by today's DCC winner, Strathinver Smart Enough, whereas Top Of The Pops is by Ch Kinsridge Top Gun. The Best Puppy, WATERCROFT TOP TIPPLE is a repeat mating, now nearly 7 1/2 months old to W Top Of The Pops.

Once again Cathy Thompson-Morgan's **BELLEVILLE SEDUCTION**, now a champion, won the Dog CC; he is by Ch Belleville Burning Passion out of Ch Belleville Intuition. **JAEVA PLAY THE ACE**, also now a champion, won the bitch CC, but she has had to play second fiddle to the dog for Best of Breed each time they met. They both now have 4 CCs each. She was bred by Martin Phillips, by Ruby Rueben ex Ch Jaeva Comfort And Joy and she is now in the joint ownership of Mrs Beatrice Phillips, Andrew Gullick and Mrs Kate Tate.

The RDCC once again was won by Jackie Phillips' **BLAKENS THE KANDY MAN KAN** from the Limit Class, repeating his win at WELKS, he is by Brenin Bazaar at Kinsridge out of **Ch Vichea Pick And Mix**. The bitch RCC went to Cathy Thompson-Morgan's **BELLEVILLE JUST MAGIC** by her unshown dog Belleville Shoelace Maker out of Belleville Magic Dice.

A new youngster won Best Puppy at her first Ch Show, Maureen McPhee's **FOXHOUSE FINE WINE** from the Minor Puppy Bitch class, she is by the newly crowned Ch Kinsridge Cash Back out of Saredon Red Wine at Foxhouse, a daughter of Ch Kinsridge Top Dollar JW and Aman Rum And Black of Saredon (Kinsridge Jack Daniels x Sealaw Taylormade).

Held this year on Friday 25th April at the Three Counties Showground at Malvern, WELKS is the first of the 'outdoor' shows – if the weather is reasonable, but rain was the order of the day and it was freezing cold so judging took place inside the vast sheds on the concrete floor. Mr Max King was judging Norfolks and both the dog and bitch CC winners gained their titles with their 3rd qualifying CCs.

Best of Breed was Diane Jenkins' *KINSRIDGE CASH **BACK**, who won his first CC as a puppy at SKC under Colin Powell; his second CC was in September last year from Paul Wilkinson, both with BOB. He has an international pedigree with English, American and German dogs among his antecedents; his dam, Am Ch Kinsridge Hot Tip has a remarkable record, first she produced Ch Kinsridge Top Score (by Ch Kinsridge Top Gun) here in England then while visiting the USA she was made an American champion there, and also produced a litter by Ch/Am Cause For Celebration containing the top US winner Am GCh Venerie Ticket To Ride and his litter sister Am Ch Venerie Tip The Scale. Covered again by 'Dickie', Coco's son, she crossed the Atlantic once more with Peter Green and back with Diane Jenkins in July 2012 she produced the two brothers, KINSRIDGE QUIDS IN and KINSRIDGE CASH BACK, so he is her fourth champion offspring. Through this mating

we now have two dogs of Elisabeth Matell's Cracknor blood lines at stud in England.

Martin Phillip bred the Bitch CC winner *JAEVA PLAY THE ACE, made up at only her 4th Championship show at 14 months old. She is now in the joint ownership of his mother, Mrs Beatrice Phillips, Andrew Gullick and Mrs Kate Tate. She won her first CC at LKA last December under Mr Albert Wight, her second on 5th April from Mr Barry Day at National Terrier. She is by one of the first litters to be sired by Ruby Rueben (2 CCs) out of Ch Jaeva Comfort And Joy, a daughter of Ch Jaeva For Petes Sake.

Both the RDCC and the RBCC went to Jackie Phillips with litter brother and sister **BLAKENS THE KANDY MAN KAN** and **CH BLAKENS SUGAR CANDY KISSES**. They are sired by Brenin Bazaar at Kinsridge out of Jackie's first Champion Vichea Pick And Mix; both are red taking after their sire in colour, as their dam is black & tan.

Best Puppy was Cathy Thompson-Morgan's **BELLEVILLE SUMMER CRUNCH**, sired by Jacquidon Tough As A Nut, a Ch Kinsridge Top Gun son, from the 2013 Crufts Best of Breed Ch Belleville Honey Nut Crunch's first litter.

National Terrier Club's show is traditionally held on the first Saturday in April, this year on the 5th, at Bingley Hall on the Staffordshire County Showground near Stafford. Norfolks were judged by Barry Day, a Norwich specialist.

Winning his third qualifying CC with Best of Breed was Cathy Thompson-Morgan's black & tan **BELLEVILLE SEDUCTION***, following his BOB at Crufts and at the last show in December, LKA when he was also Group 4. He is bred in the purple – or red – as in his first three generations only two bitches out of 14 dogs on his pedigree are not champions. His sire is Ch Belleville Burning Passion and his dam is Ch Belleville Intuition, both are red in colour.

Martin Phillips bred the Bitch CC winner JAEVA PLAY THE ACE, her second such award as she also won her first at LKA. She is now in the joint ownership of Martin's mother Mrs Beatrice Phillips, Andrew Gullick and Kate Tate. She is from one of the first litters sired by Ruby Rueben ShCh out of Ch Jaeva Comfort And Joy.

The Dog RCC went to Norma Newton's **STRATHINVER SMART ENOUGH** who now has 1 CC & BoB plus 4 RCCs to his name; he is by the Swedish imported dog Guestlings Fairbanks at Kinsridge out of Strathinver Red Red Rose.

Cathy Thompson-Morgan had a really good day, as she also owned and bred the BRCC in **BELLEVILLE JUST MAGIC**, by Belleville Shoelace Maker out of Belleville Magic Dice, as well as the Best Puppy with her half-brother just six months old, **BELLEVILLE ROLL BY**, who is out of Ch Belleville Roll The Dice.

Ruth Gee's **WATERCROFT IN A PICKLE** won the special National Terrier Open Show Pup of the Year class from 14 other puppies who had won Best Puppy in Show at Open Shows in 2013. The judge for this class was Mr Brian Baxter.

Beverley Ackling has recently learned that her dog **RUBY RUEBEN** has been awarded a ShCh for his wins at Open Shows. He is only the 3rd Norfolk to receive this award. He was bred by Mrs Nevill-Gliddon by Jaeva Gorden Bennet out of Jaeva Bee-Good

To compete at Crufts is the pinnacle of last year's showing season where only dogs that have qualified at championship shows during the year or have won a Stud Book Number are eligible to compete. It was held at the N E C in Birmingham, and Terrier Day this year was on the second day, Friday 7th March. Norfolks were 3rd in the ring after Dandie Dinmont and Norwich Terriers and our judge was Norwich breeder, Mrs Ruth Corkhill.

Winning his second CC and Best of Breed was Cathy Thompson-Morgan's **BELLEVILLE SEDUCTION**, a black & tan dog who is nearly 17 months old, so still a junior. He is from two red parents, his sire, Ch/Fin Ch Belleville Burning Passion won here two years ago and is now in Finland; his dam is Ch Belleville Intuition (Ch Belleville Thunder Struck x Belleville Rendition). He won his first CC at LKA in December.

The Bitch CC went to Karen Hurrion's **CH VILLASSA CHERRY RIPPLE**, this was her 7th CC; she is 2 years and 4 months old, a red bitch by Wharfvalley Diamond Bright at Moortop out of Karen's first champion, Valentines Cherry Crumble (Ch Belleville Premonition out of Tyark Treacle).

The Dog RCC and Best Puppy was a special moment for Ruth Gee when **WATERCROFT IN A PICKLE** beat his sire and a kennelmate among others for this award. He is by Strathinver Smart Enough out of Watercroft Hot Love (Ch Belleville Angello – Watercroft Hot Stuff).

The Bitch RCC went to the 2nd in Open Bitch, Jackie Phillips' **CH BLAKENS SUGAR CANDY KISSES**, a red bitch just out of junior; she is sired by Brenin Bazaar at Kinsridge, a red dog by the Swedish import Guestlings Fairbanks at Kinsridge out of Kinsridge More Trouble, a **Ch Belleville Rumour Nothing** daughter. Her dam is Jackie's first champion, black & tan Vichea Pick And Mix who was bred by Jane Devereux; she is by **Ch Jaeva For Petes Sake** out of b&t Vichea Piquet Player.

There was a surprisingly large Veteran Dog class of 9 entered (2 absent) which was headed by John Mitchell's **CH ROXWAY DIRECT LINE** from the German entry, Heike Mark's **GER CH MARKS THEODOR**. Mary Atkinson's very active 12 year old **CH HOBSONS CHOICE AT MOORTOP** won the Veteran Bitch class from 4 other bitches, including two with famously remembered affixes, **IR CH CRACKNOR CUTTING EDGE** and **NANFAN CHICK PEA**.
