The Championship Show of the Norfolk Terrier Club of GB was held at Weedon Village Hall and took place on Saturday 24th September. The judge, a specialist Norfolk Breeder for many years, **Mrs Patsy Green** drew the best entry seen out this year of 69 dogs in the catalogue making a total of 74 entries; actually appearing in the ring were 15 dogs with 4 absent and 36 bitches from the 50 entered. The hall was just the right size for the entry, and the delicious catering and friendly dogs - and people contributed to a very happy atmosphere. Many thanks to all the committee who worked so hard to make this a success. We were very glad too to see our webmaster over from Germany, Baerbel Lang.

Patsy's choice for Best In Show, and winning her crowning 3rd CC on the day was Dot Britten's **KRISMA NIP IN THE AIR**, at two & a half years old, she was sired by **Ch Kinsridge Cash Back** out of Krisma Nip In The Bud.

Today Di Jenkins and **CH KINSRIDGE TOP TIP** had to be content with the Bitch RCC. I hope Dot nipped to the pub to celebrate with Di Jenkins the 5 CC winners including now 3 champions that Dosh - **Ch Kinsridge Cash Back** has sired this year. His others are **Ch Kinsridge Back Chat** and **Ch Blakens Pay Back** and the CC winners are Krisma Dark N'Stormy and Kinsridge Hey Ho. **Ch Blakens Pay Back** has in turn sired dual CC winner Watercroft Pick Of The Pops. The new champion's previous CCs were won last year at LKA (Judge Diane Jenkins) and in August recently at Bournemouth under Andrew Hunt.

In the Open Dog class there was strong competition as four champions were being shown, and today **CH BLAKENS I LOOK TO YOU** came out on top with the CC. A black & tan dog owned by Mary Atkinson, but shown today by his breeder Jackie Phillips, he is just 3 years old now by Mary's **Ch Moortop No Choice** out of Vision Express at Blakens.

The RCC in Dogs went to the 2nd in Open Dog, Norma Newton's **CH STRATHINVER SEA THE STARS**, who will be 2 years old at the end of November. Homebred he is by Strathinver Smart Enough (2 CCs) out of Strathinver Reddy To Star.

Jill Stevenson's minor puppy dog was adjudged Best Puppy, **BRICKIN POT OF PICKLE** followed his success a week ago at Darlington. He is by **Ch Watercroft In A Pickle** out of Brickin Wild Ivy.

Belying her years, Karen Hurrion's **CH VALENTINES CHERRY CRUMBLE** was Best Veteran, with a lovely outline and neat waistline, she powered round the ring with great enthusiasm; no one would think she had had 8 puppies in her last litter.
