Well sprung ribs, level topline that he keeps on the move, good tail shape, moved out well once he got into his stride.

PD (3) 1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Back Chat, cracking puppy out of the top draw who I am sure is destined for top honours. Very balanced throughout, good size, best of heads with a keen eye & expression. Pleasing reach of neck set in well placed shoulders, short compact body, best of quarters, well let down hocks, soundest of movers with excellent reach & drive, harsh coat & presented to perfection, BP; 2 Atkinson's Moortop Marks Delivery, very typical throughout but not as forward as the winner on the day. Balanced head with a good eye shape & pleasing expression. Stands on the best of legs & feet, good spring of rib, moved well; 3 Atkinson's Moortop Jack The Lad at Manybrook.

**JD** (3-1) 1 Thompson-Morgan's **Belleville Scintillation**, very smart b/t, small & compact with very a typical appearance throughout. Good head & eye, neat ears, strong neck set, in well placed shoulders. Short cobby body, nicely angulated hindquarters, pleasing tailset & carriage, moved soundly; 2 Phillips' **Blakens Pay Back**, very typy, excellent bone & substance & soundly constructed throughout. Pleasing head shape of correct proportions, dark eye & alert expression. Good straight front, well sprung ribs, best of quarters, good harsh coat, sound mover.

**ND** (2) 1 Mounfield's **Arderry Son Of A Gun**, pleasing sort, good size & presents a balanced outlook. Well proportioned throughout, good head & eye, firm level topline that he keeps on the move,

1 Newton's **Strathinver Smart Enough**, such a sound honest dog, good size & is very well made throughout. Best of heads, good eye shape & a very typical expression. JB (7-3) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Magic Spirit, another very typical one from this kennel, beautifully balanced, small & compact & very well made throughout. Good head & expression, strong neck, excellent layback of shoulder, short backed & well rounded quarters. Once she settled a very sound & positive mover; 2 Darnell's Jacquidon Next Sensation, pleasing eye & nicely balanced throughout with good bone & substance. Typical in head & eye, straight front, good spring of rib, firm quarters, good tailset & carriage, moved soundly; 3 Walshe's Monalou Bagel at Bertias; R Batey & Gee's Watercroft Confetti.

**NB** (2-1) 1 Mounfield's **Arderry She's The One**, alone but a worthy winner. Very well made with a pleasing outlook. Balanced head, good strength of

muzzle, lovely dark eye & that keen & intelligent expression the standard asks for. Well sprung ribs, good width of hindquarters, sound on the move.

Sound gassy mover, in a quality coat & well presented, BP; 2 Atkinson's Moortop Mark Delivery, not quite the head of 1 & his eye a little round in shape. Nice front, forechest & well sprung body. Good turn of stifle, strongly made behind which showed in his sound movement, tail set on well. It was a delight to be back in the ring with one of my favourite breeds & I appreciated the good sized entry. I always enjoy the battle between handlers & their charges as they must be amongst the most self willed of all the breeds I judge & their antics can cause me to smile. The highlight of the day was when the lovely BOB winner went on to win the group. Wonderful!

PD (6-2) 1 Atkinson's Moortop Marks Delivery, he simply dominated the class from the second he entered the ring. So compact, well weighted boned, big ribcage, short loin, ample neck & the harshest of jackets which is so dense & tight fitting. His head is balanced, good width, deep stop & that strength in foreface. His eyes almost twinkled with his mischief but he showed his heart out & moved out in a beautifully controlled & purposeful style. Must have a bright future; 2 Gee's Watercroft Coin A Phrase, this b/t was not so advanced nor as settled on the move as the winner. He is short backed, level backline, well muscled hindquarters with a decent width in thigh & strong hocks. Not so finished in head as Marks, still needing to fill out in muzzle & he was reluctant to lift his ears as effectively. Well coated & once he got going he was quite sound; 3 Lloyd's Orison Custom Cut; R Broom's Roxway Book Seller.

**JD** (2-1) 1 Jenkins' **Kinsridge Back Chat**, a bit of a handful on the move, but this handsome headed all male youngster could not hide his charms. For breed type he is so good, strong but quality doggy head, super eyes & ears, enough neck, so well ribbed & fairly compact body. In super jacket he is eye-catching when at attention. Just needs to show a little more restraint on the move.

**PGD** (4-1) 1 Atkinson's **Blakens I Look To You**, my first impression of this b/t was that he was lovely for type with an especially appealing expression. I liked his size, good width behind the withers, nice forechest & such a firm level back. He is compact, has well muscled hams & such a harsh, thick coat.

Excellent tailset & carriage & he is a confident purposeful mover; 2 Broom & Davies' Roxway Quite Enough, I appreciated for his size, strong bone, excellent ribbing & well presented coat. Nice head, eye a good shape but a little full for me, very good ears & correct mouth. I also feel that he could have a little more width in thigh & more let down in hock but in fairness to him it did not stop him from striding around the ring with a confident air; 3 Brown's Dajean Dotty's Digger.

LD (4) 1 Phillips' Blakens Pay Back, such a classy looking dog which really appealed from the outset. He has style, shape, is beautifully headed, so well ribbed & short in loin giving him that compact, sturdy & powerful look in a neat package. His head is a delight, doggy but full of quality aided by that super eye shape & colour & he is so responsive to his handler that his attention never wavers. Great power on the move, impeccable in coat presentation & I was thrilled to learn that this win gives him his title. Congratulations, CC; 2 Jenkins' Krisma Flashback to Kinsridge, another excellent example of the breed & surely heading for the upper house. He is so good to go over, delightful headpiece, strong muzzle, super expression & good strength in neck. He is well bodied & muscled & side on he can motor. In what was almost a dead heat finish, I felt that Pay Back was that fraction truer in front action on the day, RCC; 3 Darnell's Jacquidon Tough As A Nut; R Ackling's Ruby Rueben.

OD (2) 1 Gee's Watercroft In A Pickle, stunning in coat & presentation & he is so firm & well muscled in body. Bags of style & swank & he is so responsive to his owner, showing non-stop. Nice head, very good neck & head carriage, firm back & enough let down in hock. He added to the appeal of the challenge but I felt he was not quite as positive in front action as the two I put over him; 2 Lloyd's Orison Midnight Myth, smaller & finer all through for my taste. Pleasing head, very good eyes & ears, could have heavier bone to aid his cause & he is a



little longer in loin than the one I put over him. Lovely temperament & he went around the ring so happily.

**VD/B** (2-1) 1 Howard's **Hatchwoods Flamenco**, 7 years old bitch who was very much out of coat which drew attention to her somewhat generous width in front! Sweet temperament, pretty head with such a feminine air, carrying a little too much bodyweight which was reflected in her action. But she was happy!

GCD/B (2) 1 Howard's Hatchwoods Flamenco; 2 Brown's Dajean Dotty's Digger, what an engaging little person this was. Regrettably too long in leg for me & that was exaggerated by his being so short of jacket making me think Summer really was here. He has lovely eyes, a super nature & he just oozes self confidence on the move.

**PB** (8-2) 1 Gullick & Tate's **Jaeva Hells Fire**, what a gorgeous baby this is. Head already well developed, so correctly proportioned, lovely skull width, gorgeous eyes & ears & that expression will win many admirers. Robust in body, excellent coat which is so dense & fitting, neck & outline is so what is aimed for & she strutted her way around the ring with much drive & a hint of arrogance & superiority. What a prospect, RCC, BP; 2 Dixon & Davies' Perrisblu Priscilla, ordinarily a bitch of this stamp would be a shoe in winner in a PB class, but she was unlucky to meet a rising star so early in her career. Lots to like, lovely size, strongly made throughout but undeniably feminine in outlook. Immaculate in jacket & she never gave her handler a moments trouble. She moves around the ring with such precision & her head carriage adds to her 3 Stevenson's Brickin Simplicity; R Atkinson's Moortop Just The One; VHC Lloyd's Orison Calm Attitude.

JB (5-1) 1 Britten's Krisma Nip In The Air, I see she is half sister to the JD winner, both being by Ch K Cash Back. She appealed for sheer type & quality in head & expression. Her body shape is balanced, the back level & firm, short in loin & well angulated hindquarters. So well put down in coat & muscle & she covered the ground so effectively with strong hock use; 2 Darnell's Jacquidon Next Sensation, this b/t played her handler up so much on the move. Good to go over, especially liked her head proportions & that almost wicked expression from good eyes. Perhaps a little short in neck for me, but well sprung

ribs, strong bone & good feet; 3 Cooper's **Settrenda Sweet N Tiddly**; R Lloyd's **Orison Midnight Stroll**.

PGB (6-3) 1 Hess & Higgins' Umbrage The Gloriana, nice for size, such a good spring of rib & they carry well back to nicely angulated hindquarters & strong hocks. A little short in the neck for me, pleasing head & very good mouth. Spotless in jacket & quite sound as she went around the ring; 2 Gardener's Perrisblu Liberty at Danalas, a really good head on this slightly overweight bitch which has resulted in her being a little loaded in shoulder. She is a good size, strong bone, level back & she is blessed with a decent neck. In good coat she just lacked the light footedness of the winner; 3 Howard's Hatchwoods Last Tango.

LB (3) 1 Philip's Nordalset Truly Madly, I liked her for size & length/height proportions. So firm in backline with a decent head carriage adding to her charm. Correct size, ample substance throughout, well shaped & angulated, strong hocks & in lovely coat. Attractive head with good width of skull & well held ears, decent length of neck & level topline & upright tail carriage gave a balanced outline, but not quite so positive behind as 1.

PD (4) 1 Gee's Watercroft Coin A Phrase, beautifully presented b/t in gleaming coat, with good length of neck & good shoulders & straight front legs so able to stride out & cover ground well when moving. Charming head with broad skull, neat ears & short muzzle giving attractive expression, teeth just OK. Quality bone & well bodied, BPD; 2 S Starring Roll; 3 Brooms Roxway Book Seller; R Lloyd's Orison Custom Cut.

**JD** (2) A very close decision between these two youngsters of similar age of just 13 months. Both expertly presented in excellent coat.

1 Jenkins' **Kinsridge Back Chat**, slightly shorter in back & when he pulls himself together looks a king with his most attractive head & expression, super neck flowing into sloping shoulders, level topline, short back & proudly held tail. Put up a very good performance on the move, good bend of stifle, with low hocks giving him plenty of drive from the rear, he just missed out on the RCC spot on maturity – he will surely be reigning soon; 2 Atkinson's **Moortop** 

Marks Delivery, a very promising dog, unlucky to meet 1, with expressive dark eye & well carried ears, slightly more upright in shoulder, but straight front legs with neat cat feet, good spring of ribs & in hard condition with well-toned muscles with harsh coat, he was moving well too.

dark, and is a tad too short in muzzle, attractive overall but was a bit lack lustre today and needed more careful trimming of the topline; R Devereux's Vichea Little Gem; VHC Hess & Higgins' Umbrage The Jubilant.

**OB** (4) This was such a good class down to lower placings. 1 Jenkins' Ch Kinsridge Top Tip, top winning bitch and you can see why when you judge her, she has that indefinable extra something, excels in breed type and although in a short coat on the day does not have a lot to hide, good head and mouth, being pick I would prefer a darker eye, but size and shape is correct, correct length of neck short back and good tail set, great outline when standing and not being heavy through the shoulder she beat the male for BIS. I love both of them but this bitch does have a style and quality many do not have, is smart as paint. BCC and BIS; 2 Hurrion's Villassa Star **Turn**, she is a bigger one but is full of quality, I liked her a lot, lovely type of head, correct for mouth and eye, cobby well balanced body, good topline and tail set, correct for bone and substance, moved better in front than 3, in excellent coat and showed well; 3 Gee's Watercroft Top Tia, better for size than 2 and the very best of tails for shape and carriage, lovely type with pretty head though could have more stop, doesn't have the balance of the other 2 due to her legs being a shade too short, but she does look a picture standing with her short back and lovely tail, in great coat and condition, showed all the time. A pity I didn't have 3 firsts for this class; R Gee's Watercroft Pick Of The Pops.

**VB** (4-2) 1 Atkinson's **Ch Hobsons Choice at Moortop**, fantastic 12 year old so obviously enjoying herself, attractive head, still a good topline and well made body, out moved many of the younger ones. **BVIS**; 2 Hurrion's **Ch Valentines Cherry Crumble**, lovely 7 year of of beautiful type, pretty head, cobby and short backed, moved well considering she was a shade fat, in excellent coat and condition.

Pleasant head with big teeth. Rather rangy in build and looking high on leg but this was not helped by the fact that he was in very short coat with little to no furnishings. As you will see, he reappeared in every class, so he certainly got in some practice.

**JD** (3) 1 Gee's **Watercroft Coin A Phrase**, a smart b&t moving out well in profile. Very masculine and generally well put together. Pleasing head and good bite. He impressed with his well placed shoulders and clean neck line. Strong body and excellent tail, well set and straight; 2 Atkinson's **Moortop Marks Delivery**, an attractive puppy of good type. Excellent red coat in good condition. Strong head and well proportioned. Moved well. Heavier in shoulder than 1 and not as good in front movement; 3 Ward & Hamar's **Gorden's Boy**.


