PD (3-2) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Slipknot NAF, what a cracking puppy to start the day with! He excels for type and has the most delightful head and expression with nice breadth to skull, wedge-shaped muzzle of correct length, dark oval-shaped eyes, good ears for size and set and correct dentition. Compact in outline with moderate length of neck, short level back, good length of ribcage, rib developing well, short muscular loin and good tail set. He is so well made he just cannot stand wrong and he moves true and with purpose. Quality coat and presentation. BP and later placed 4th in the Puppy Group.

JD (2) 1 Stevenson's Brickin Pot Of Pickle, this 12 mth old was an easy winner in this class. Quality youngster of excellent type and balance. He presented a compact outline with strong neck of moderate length, firm level topline, well sprung ribs which are carried well back, short loin and excellent tail set. Attractive, well proportioned head with good width between his correctly set ears, dark expressive eyes, strong wedge-shaped muzzle and scissor bite. Well laid shoulders, standing nice and straight in front on good feet, muscular hindquarters with good turn of stifle. Moving true and using himself to advantage. Delightful temperament, RBD; 2 Philip's Nordalset Made To Boogie, 13 mth of different type to the winner, not nearly as mature and slightly longer cast. Pleasing head and expression with nice breadth to skull, well defined stop, strong wedge-shaped muzzle of correct length, excellent eye for shape and colour and correct dentition. Ears are well set but a little larger. Strong neck of medium length, rib developing well and tail set on well. Slightly out at elbow which affects his front action but he stands on good feet. Moving well when viewed in profile and from behind. Well handled.

PGD (1) 1 Thompson-Morgan's **Belleville Slipknot** NAF, **BP**, **PG4**.

OD (1) 1 Gee's Ch Watercroft Chilli Pepper, quality boy of 21 mths and one who has done well under me previously being my BPIS winner at the Club Show last year. Since then I see he has gone on to gain his title and deservedly so. He scores for type, is masculine all through, so well balanced and as sound as they come. Super headed boy with good width between the ears, correct skull to muzzle proportions, strong wedge-shaped muzzle, dark expressive eyes, medium-sized ears of correct set and perfect dentition. He is solid all through with strong neck of moderate length, super rib, level topline, short muscular loin and good tail for set and carriage. Well made both front and rear, standing well at all times and using himself to the max on the move. Excellent coat and presentation, **BD** & **BOB**.

PB (8-3) Lovely class with some very promising young ladies in attendance.

1 Smith's Javidel Darling Buds Of May, 6 mth black/tan and what a delight she is! Of excellent type and feminine throughout, she has the most exquisite and expression; broad skull, correct proportions, well defined stop, dark expressive eyes, excellent ears for size and set and correct scissor bite. Compact in outline with moderate length of neck, short back, pleasing rib for one so young, muscular loin and tail set on well. Well laid shoulders, nice straight forelegs, excellent feet, well muscled hindquarters with good turn of stifle. Moving true on the down and back and moving out with purpose when viewed in profile. Good quality coat. Best Puppy Bitch & RBB; 2 Gee's Watercroft Suzie'Q, 7 mth of different type to the winner and not making her handler's life easy! Feminine girl and another good one to go over, presenting a super compact outline. Strong neck of moderate length, short level back, rib developing well, muscular loin cc and tail set on correctly. Quality head with the most delightful expression; good skull to muzzle cc proportions, well defined stop, strong wedge-shaped Open



muzzle, excellent eye and ears of correct size and set. Another who is soundly constructed with good layback of shoulder, straight forelegs and standing on good feet. Well muscled thighs and good turn of stifle. Moving out well in profile and nice and straight in front but just a fraction wider going away. Quality coat and presentation; 3 Stevenson's Brickin All For The Best; Res Watkins' Brickin Summer Chorus; VHC Philip's Nosymitsio Redimp at Nordalset.

JB (5-3) 1 Smith's Javidel Darling Buds Of May, RBB; 2 Macartney's Ivrig First Bit Of Joy, 13 mth who was unlucky to come up against the top quality puppy. This girl has plenty of qualities. Attractive headpiece with nice breadth between her well set ears, well defined stop, strong muzzle although a shade longer, expressive eyes of good colour and correct dentition. Strong neck of moderate length, firm level topline, well sprung rib and muscular loin, but not quite as compact in outline as the winner. Moving out well in profile. Good texture to coat.

PGB (0)

OB (3-2) 1 Gee's **Watercroft Saffron**, 21 mth bitch. Not quite in full coat but a quality girl nonetheless and so good to go over. She greatly appealed for type, is feminine throughout and so well made. Attractive head of correct proportions, strong wedge-shaped muzzle, dark expressive eyes, excellent ears and correct dentition. Muscular girl with strong neck of correct length, short level back, excellent rib, strong loin and first class tail for set and carriage. Well laid shoulders, standing nice and straight in front on good feet and nice turn of stifle. Moving soundly and with purpose all through, **BB**.

Level topline, moved well when he settled, Best Puppy Dog, RBD; 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Slipknot, good for size, pleasing head & expression, correct eye shape, nice front, level topline, tail on top, moved well; 3 Hurrion's Villassa Jack Daniels; Res Gee's Watercroft Dream On.

JD (2-1) 1 Horne's **Marchdens Mark My Words**, nice for size, with a compact body, straight front on good feet, enough rib, harsh coat.

PGD (2-1) 1 Thompson-Morgan's **Belleville Slipknot**.

OD (3-2) 1 Gee's **Ch Watercroft Chilli Pepper**, all male, well balanced dog, has a stunning head, dark eye & neat well placed ear. Good length of neck, harsh coat, compact body, excellent rear angulation, moved well with tail on top, **BD**.

PB (9-4) 1 Phillips' Jaeva Keen As Mustard, quality youngster who is so good on the table, super head & expression, dark well shaped eye, good neck & shoulders, correct tailset, never stopped showing, moved with ease & confidence, BP & RBB; 2 Hurrion's Villassa Country Belle, feminine head, clean front, excellent feet, well ribbed for age, nice bend of stifle, moved well; 3 Gee's Watercroft Suzie'Q; Res Brittain's Lexinor Rising Star; VHC Smith's Javidel Darling Buds Of May.

JB (4-1) 1 Darnell's **Jacquidon No Hesitation**, alert expression, neat well placed ear, good bone, short back with harsh coat, well ribbed, nice constructed rear, moved well; 2 Macartney's **Ivrig First Bit Of Joy**, nice type with keen expression, true front, well placed shoulders, harsh coat, moved good in front, would like more drive from rear; 3 Smith's **Javidel**

Darling Buds Of May.

PGB (2-1) 1 Darnell's **Jacquidon Next Sensation**, lovely expression, dark eye, compact body, pleasing neck & shoulders, level topline, well muscled rear, moved with confidence.

OB (2) 1 Thompson-Morgan's **Allright Black Bess** (Imp), so good for size, pleasing outline, super head, well placed ears, good neck & shoulders, compact body with harsh coat, level topline standing & on the move, so well developed rear, pleasure to watch her move, tail on top, well presented. **BB** & **BOB**, so pleased to watch her gain **G3**; 2 Gee's **Watercroft Saffron**, very feminine bitch of good type, neat ear with lovely eye shape, super front with good feet, good topline, correct tail carriage, moved so well with plenty of drive.

A very pleasing entry of 58 dogs. I thought that the overall quality was pretty good with coats in the main OK. Hindquarters were generally better than fronts but I thought that heads were in the main good overall. I thought that a number of exhibits could have been rather more compact. I noticed quite a few dogs with tails stripped out rather too much which does not give a typical appearance.

VD (2) 1 Green's Ch Wharfvalley Diamond Star, a shorter made dog than 2, good in topline, good head with the correct breadth of skull. Good eye. Well sprung in rib. Good coat. Moved well behind. It was his general outline that took him to no 1 here; 2 Simpson's Umbrage Longton Cum Megalex, slightly better in front than 1. Good neck & OK in coat. Not quite the compactness of the winner. A pity she stalled at one point when moving.

PD (2) 1 Thompson-Morgan's **Belleville Slipknot** NAF, a much smaller dog than 2 very pleasing in head & expression, enough bone for his age good harsh coat for age too, & correct level topline. Could move with a shade more drive behind but accurate movement all round. Good compact shape. **BP**; 2 Hurrion's **Villassa Jack Daniels**, plenty of size for his age. Good in skull but ears need to settle. Good in hindquarters but needs to finish with a shorter look when fully mature. Good coat & correct spring of rib.

JD (4) 1 Horne's Marchdens Mark My Words, a very good dog of an excellent & typical shape & proportions, Good broad skull with good eye & correct well carried ears. Very good shoulder & front. Good round feet. Moved with slightly more drive behind than 2. Excellent coat & body & really good in topline, with well set on tail. Finished up winning the RCC; 2 Stevenson's Brickin Pot Of Pickle, another pleasing young dog with not quite as good a coat as 1 right now. He too was good in skull with correct ears, moved well in front & OK behind. Enough spring of rib & correct in loin;

3 Jellings & Bakewell's Jaeva Look 'N' Look Again at Norwelston Lynjel, very much a baby compared to the two above & just coming into coat but promising & good in skull but needs time to develop in muzzle. Good typical outline & correct body for age. Well set on tail & moved well behind; Res Philip's Nordalset Made To Boogie.

PGD (3) Two close up exhibits in the first two here. 1 Hamar's Gordons Boy, slightly smaller than 2 & I thought went slightly better in front than he did. Good skull to muzzle proportions & enough stop. Correct level topline & good round feet; 2 Darnell's Jacquidon Tough as A Nut, a strongly made dog with good body & correct rib. Correct skull & muzzle. Good bone & typical outline. Shown in good coat but not quite the front of 1; 3 Brown's Dajean Dotty's Digger, OK in skull but not shown in great coat today & tail not so good. He could move more positively in front but had good temperament & seemed to enjoy himself.

LD (2-1) 1 Atkinson's **Charlie Blake at Moortop**, stood alone but a very pleasing dog shown with just the right amount of coat of good texture. Excellent tailset & carriage. Very good head & expression. Good ears not too big & OK in eye. Moved better behind but his enthusiasm at times didn't help his front movement. Enough neck & had much type.

OD (5) Thought the first two here to be very good typy examples of the breed.

1 Jenkins' **Ch Kinsridge Back Chat**, shown in really good harsh coat with plenty of it & in good condition. Typical in head & expression with enough stop. Pleasing in muzzle. Eye could be darker. Correct proportions. Enough neck without being overdone there. Good shoulder & correct round feet. Excellent bone & moved out well in front & behind. Correct body & rib. Went on to win the **CC**; 2 Newton's **Ch Strathinver Sea The Stars**, another pleasing dog whose coat was not quite at its best today but he moved out well also. OK in ears. Good



strength of muzzle. Good eye & OK in feet. Good in topline & enough bone; 3 Petrova & Zilotina's **Rus Ch Terravirtus Edinburgh Duke**, very pleasing in head & expression & good compact shape. Very good compact body with correct level topline & therefore a good typical outline. Good feet & correct coat for her age; 3 Hurrion's Villassa County Belle, a pleasing youngster but could be a shade more compact in body. When fully coated this should make her look more compactly proportioned. Excellent tailset & carriage. Good neck & moved out well; Res Stevenson's Brickin All For The Best.

JB (6-2) 1 Gullick & Tate's Jaeva Keen As Mustard, not a big bitch & quite young compared to the others here. Very good in neck, topline & tailset. Moved out pretty well in front & behind. Enough bone. Good hindquarters with enough bend of stifle & yet OK in hocks. Shown in better coat than 2. Enough body for age. Pleasing overall outline; 2 Macartney's Ivrig First Bit Of Joy, not moving quite so well in front as 1, but good in skull & OK in topline. Could be better in tail carriage but

well muscled behind. Correct spring of rib & good round feet; 3 Glynn's **Kenberlynn Angels Wings**, needs time to develop in head, & coat not at its best today. Plenty of body substance & well muscled in hindquarters. Scored for overall shape & compactness; 2 Gee's Watercroft Saffron, rather bigger type. Very sound indeed with excellent movement in front & behind. She has a good rib & correct level topline; 3 Hurrion's Villassa Cherry Tart, not quite the coat of the other two today & not as compact as 1. Good in head with correct breadth of skull & typical ears well carried. Good eye & correct muzzle. Good bone & correct round feet. Could do better when in better coat; Res Atkinson's Moortop Clear Choice; VHC Devereux's Vichea Little Gem.

OB (5-1) A good class with two bitches of real quality at its head.

1 Jenkins' **Ch Kinsridge Top Tip**, a very typy bitch. Really good in neck & topline & OK for size. She is well balanced in proportions with good compact appearance & correct level topline, She scored in head & strength of muzzle & moved well in front & behind. Good coat at its best & well bent stifles without being overdone there. When not concentrating can at times stand untidily in front & doesn't always use her ears well but overall she has great type,



quality & movement & went on to take the CC & BOB; 2 Phillips' Ch Blakens Tootie Fruitie, another one with an excellent coat & really typical shape & outline. Very good in head & ears. Could maybe be said to have scored in eye over 1 but not in dentition. Good in front & strode out well. I had no hesitation in awarding her the RCC; 3 Gee's Watercroft Pick Of The Pops, another pleasing bitch with a good body, plenty of spring of rib. Not quite the expression of 1 & 2 but scored in movement over some others in this class in front & behind. Tail could be better carried; Res Morozova's Terravirtus Flame Of Olympic.

GCB (2-1) 1 Macartney's Nordalset Little Bit Of Sun for Ivrig, very pleasing bitch in good coat. Moved pretty well behind & OK in front. Good tailset. Plenty of muscle. Good round feet. Good eye & enough breadth of skull. Could have a shade more neck to complete the picture.

Very nice head, lovely eye and good layback of shoulder, upper arm and front. Not the coat of 1. Showed himself off very well; 3 Stevenson's **Brickin Heart Throb**; Res Nunez's **Cherokee At Treehouse**.

JD (2-1) 1 Hurrion's **Villassa Jack Daniels**, very showy and in excellent coat, level topline, bone OK would prefer longer rib with more spring. Small eye good bite moved well on the long grass. Well carried tail.

PGD (2) 1 Standen's **Villassa Jack Be Quick**, lovely to go over, beautiful head, good width to skull, strong muzzle, good bite and ears. Correct bone, nice layback of shoulder, could have a longer rib and a bit more weight, not yet mature. Well carried tail. Would like to see him in a years' time when he has matured; 2 Walker's **Hedgefield Brucey Baby**, a quality dog with good bone and head, nice eye, good bite and in good coat, just needs the finishing touches. Not the tail of 1 and longer cast. Front not as straight.

LD (4-1) 1 Stevenson's **Brickin Pot Of Pickle**, beautiful, well balanced typy dog, short, cobby, compact, lovely head with good width to skull, very strong muzzle, small oval eye, great bone and spring of rib. Excellent harsh coat. Moved well both ways, striding out. Well muscled hind quarters with good

angulation. **CC** & **BOB** on his overall type and compactness, the closest to my ideal of the overall picture. Compactness is something we are losing in the breed and needs to be addressed; 2 Atkinson's **Charlie Blake at Moortop**, another lovely dog with excellent bone, strong muzzle, beautiful, dark, small, oval eye, not the width of skull of 1 and not as short in back. Good length of rib which is lacking in many, lovely tail carriage, moved well; 3 Brown's **Dajean Dotty's Digger**.

OD (2) 1 Horne's **Ch Marchdens Mark My Words**, a very typy dog with a good head, lovely bone, excellent tail carriage, moved better than 2 but longer cast, very good spring of rib, harsh coat, very good hind quarters. **RCC**, although he moved better than the CC winner he is not short and compact; 2 Gullick and Stuivenberg's **Ch Arderry Penny Red to Jaeva**, a quality dog with a beautiful head, good shoulder layback, moved very well in front. Short back. Preferred hind angulations and muscle of 1, also not the rib or bone of 1.

PB (4-1) 1 Gee's **Watercroft Gold Dust**, and she is, absolutely beautiful 6 month puppy, outstanding for type, lovely head, eye & ears, good bite. JD (3) 1 Hurrion & Standen's Villassa Jack Be Quick, well I just fell for him, gorgeous head, all in proportion, he made me smile. His skeletal make up is so correct, that he doesn't put a foot wrong, standing or moving. Excellent presentation of super hard wiry coat. I wouldn't change a thing. **DCC** & **BOB**; 2 Walshe's **Beritas The Name's Bond**, shows himself off to advantage. Dark well set eye with that cheeky spark. Confident use of ear. And I judged her again in the veteran group and she was up there in the quality shortlist; 2 Hurrion's Ch Valentines Cherry Crumble, Lovely girl, again really doing her job with purpose. Also a lovely and enjoyable dinner where I was presented with a lovely watercolour of our Norfolk Marcus painted by Pippa Thew. And not least important: the show attracted an entry of 104 made by 99 dogs.

Chief Steward Max King did a great job keeping as well the judge as the exhibitors under control to make sure the time table was adhered to. Ably assisted by Claire Rogers, Preston Hafenden and Peter Baxter.

The overall quality of exhibits was far better than I had expected and many difficult and close decisions had to be made. I was very impressed with temperament – and I don't think a single dog objected to being handled by the judge and most showed themselves off with great enthusiasm. One or two with too much enthusiasm, but I think it is only lovely to watch terriers being terriers!

GCD (2-1) 1 Brown's **Dajean Dotty's Digger**, strong masculine dog of a pleasing type. Excellent body, bone, legs and feet. Lovely temperament and moved OK. Incorrect bite.

VD (2) 1 Simpson's **Umbrage Longton cum Megalex**, 8 years old and in good shape. Pleasing head and expression Longer in body than I like, but lovely bone and excellent coat texture. Irregular bite. Moved OK. Best Veteran Dog; 2 Gee's **Watercroft Hot News**, just over 7 years old and a very nice shape and outline. Balanced head and short back, but incorrect bite and missing teeth. Moved OK.

SVD (Special Vintage Dog)(1) 1 Rusby's **Harrys A Hero**, more than 12 years old and in good shape for his age. Nice type and outline, temperament and condition Moved well. Irregular bite.

MPD (8-1) 1 Gee's Watercroft Calling Time, I really liked this young dog. Excellent type, with a lovely head, ears and expression, perfectly balanced neck with a short back and perfect tailset. Lovely body for his age and moved well. Showed himself off with lots of attitude! PD (3) 1 Gee's Watercroft Calling Time; beautifully balanced with a pleasing head and keen expression. Very good body, short loin and excellent spring of rib. Good topline and tailset. A really good showman in excellent condition who moved out well with some propulsion from the rear; 2 Stevenson's Brickin Quite By Chance, another good quality youngster, not the maturity of the winner as yet. Dark, keen eye, correct mouth. Good straight legs and thickly padded feet. True both coming and going; 3 Walker's Roxypark Spring Time.

JD (4) 1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Witty Banter, an exciting youngster who should make a name for himself. Good breadth of head, dark intelligent eye, strong white teeth. Short, well ribbed body with excellent topline and tailset. Moved really well with a smooth propulsive action, **CC**; 2 Horne's **Ch Marchdens Mark My Words**, grand head with keen dark eye. Good forehand with pleasing bone and thickly padded feet. Well ribbed but just a fraction longer cast than the winner. Excellent topline and tailset. Harsh, well presented jacket. Well angulated front and rear and he is most impressive on the move, **RCC**.

Even I wondered how I would get home but in the moment when we make these decisions the show must go on and indeed it did. My entry may have been decimated by the travelling conditions but the overall quality was still there in the dogs I had to go over.

MPD (3-2) 1 Walker's Roxypark Spring Time, 7 month old red of good size. Head could be more rounded which meant ears were a little high set and not always dropping close to the cheek. Eye shape was good but could be darker, head proportions were good, great bone, front construction could be better, layback of shoulder was ok. Good spring of rib, longer cast overall. Moved with vigour, tailset ok, good coat texture, enjoying his day out today with his owner.

PD (5-2) 1 Jenkins' **Kinsridge Witty Banter**, both 1 & 2 very similar in overall type. Great head & expression, typiest of heads, great teeth and bite, good neck into well laid shoulders, good length of upper arm into straight front, tight feet. Wells sprung ribs into short loin, short backed into correct tailset carried well. Moved with reach & drive, good coat

texture, well presented and showed himself off very well. Pleased to award him the CC; 2 Gee's Watercroft Calling Time, very similar in overall type to one, carries a lot of the same attributes just not quite the same front construction of 1. Great coat texture, correct Norfolk head and bite, good eye, correct neck. Short backed, good boned and well presented. Moved with reach in drive just not quite as tight coming towards me. Pleased to award him the RCC; 3 Jenkins & McCourt's Kinsridge Crackshot TAF.

JD (1) 1 Baumbach's **Wederdena's Harry Beau**, red male of lovey size, head of good proportions but could be stronger. Neck ok as was his shoulder placement. Bone was good, good spring of ribs, good bone. Moved very happily for his owner enjoying his day out.

PGD (2) 1 Baumbach's **Wederdena's Harry Beau**; 2 Walker's **Hedgefield Brucey Baby**, rangier in overall type to 1, strong head and expression, good bone with strong teeth. Head ok but lacked stop with spoilt his expression. Needs a darker eye. Tailset good. Coat coming through could benefit from more drive from behind with some road walking this would improve.
